

**EDWARDS COUNTY INTERSECTION IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM**

In conformance with the State approved procedure for establishing Rural Reference System, Edwards County has placed signs at every rural public road intersection. This map graphically illustrates the system and can be used to identify specific locations throughout the County.

The system uses the southwest corner of the County as a beginning point, denoted '0N' and '0E'. This represents the intersection of the south line of the County (Base Line '0N') and the west line of the County (Base Line '0E'). The intervals to the north and to the east, using 100 numbers per mile with the last two digits representing the tenth and hundredths of a mile. The number 200N represents a line two miles north of the south Base Line which is the South County Line. 2150N would be 21.5 miles north of the South Base Line. An intersection marked 1250N and 800E would be 12.5 miles north and 8 miles east of the Southwest corner of the County.



